Furniture Wax & Oil

Traditional waxes and oils for all new and antique timber furniture

A good coat of wax will add life and lustre to all your furniture, and a beautiful silky feel to its surfaces.

Wax will also protect your timber from staining and helps repel dust by adding a layer of protection...due to its ability to seep right through wood layers, is one of the best protecting finishes you can opt for.

Our **Traditional Furniture Wax** is easy to work with, quick to apply and is available in either **ORIGINAL** (high ratio of Carnauba to Beeswax) or **SOFT** (about half the ratio of Carnauba wax).

ORIGINAL is best for general use on all furniture.

SOFT is often used by woodworkers for vintage tools, art frames etc but is also perfectly useful for furniture.

SOFT can also be used to make White Wax (see our White Wax fact Sheet).

HOW TO

Apply with a soft cloth to a clean, dust free surface using a tight circular motion. This motion gently heats the wax and allows it to penetrate the timber surface for best protection.

Buff off with a clean, dry soft cloth.

Apply at least once a year or every six months in hot, humid climates.

Try to apply on a reasonably warm day (over 20°) for ease of application.



For regular cleaning and polishing of timber furniture, use our **All Natural Furniture Polish**.

Our polish is completely silicone, petroleum and chemical FREE and is 100% natural and non toxic.

It also contains a good amount of Vitamin E which nourishes and moisturises timber for longer life and less cracking.

Carnauba wax has been added in trace amounts to help repel dust and lock in the Vitamin E.

This polish when correctly used will not leave any residue, and will not build up over time like silicone-based polishes.

HOW TO

Gently shake the bottle.

The residue in the bottom of the bottle is a sign that chemicals have not been used to emulsify the ingredients. Shaking the bottle will ensure that the correct mix of oil/wax and additives are applied to the furniture.

Apply with a soft cloth to a clean, dust free surface using a circular motion.

Leave for a few seconds and then buff off with a soft, dry cloth.
